Biosketch

Prof. Dr. A.H. Maitland-Van der Zee (Anke-Hilse) was trained as a pharmacist (1999 Groningen University), clinical pharmacologist and epidemiologist. She obtained her PhD in 2003 at Utrecht University and worked as a postdoc at the Human Genetics Center of the University of Texas in Houston, Tx USA from 2003-2005. From 2005-2016 she worked at the Division of Pharmacoepidemiology and Clinical Pharmacology of Utrecht University first as an assistant Professor and since 2012 an associate Professor. In Sept 2016 she was appointed as a full Professor of Precision Medicine in Respiratory Disease at the Academic Medical Center in Amsterdam.

Among other things Maitland-Van der Zee is the Principal Investigator of the worldwide consortium Pharmacogenomics in Childhood Asthma (PiCA), board member of the Netherlands



Respiratory Society (NRS), secretary of the Netherlands Society of Clinical Pharmacology and Biopharmacy (NVKFB) and president of the Federation Innovative Drug Research Netherlands (FIGON). Next to that she is the initiator and board member of the European research network Pharmacogenetics/Genomics (within the European Federation of Pharmaceutical Science (EUFEPS)). Maitland-Van der Zee published more than 160 international publications in scientific journals, among others in the New England Journal of Medicine.
