Anneke ten Brinke is working in the Pulmonary Department at the Medical Centre Leeuwarden, in Leeuwarden, The Netherlands. She was trained in pulmonary medicine at the Medical Spectrum Twente Hospital in Enschede and the Leiden University Medical Centre. From 1998-2001 she followed a research fellowship in the latter hospital under supervision of Prof. Dr. Peter Sterk and Prof. Dr. Elisabeth Bel, with whom she is still collaborating. She was appointed to her present post in Leeuwarden in 2001 and started a specialized severe asthma service. Her research focuses on severe asthma, with a particular emphasis on the phenotyping, pathophysiological mechanisms, monitoring and therapeutic approaches. She is an active member of several respiratory societies including the American Thoracic Society, the European Respiratory Society and the Dutch Respiratory Society.
