

The masterclass sessions are best suited for junior participants, including PhD students, fellows and junior post-docs. The master class requires your active participation: you will present data, not the Keynote speaker. This will provide you the opportunity to discuss your work (projected as a e-poster, containing max 3 figures) in a small group chaired by an established researcher and recognized expert in the field.

To ensure the lively character and to allow extensive feedback from the keynote speakers in these master classes, the number of active participants is maximized at 10 per master class. In the event that the number of interested participants exceeds 10, participants will be selected based on time of subscription (first in) and their current position (preference will be given to PhD students, fellows and junior post-docs). A maximum of two non-presenting senior discussants will also be allowed (first in). You can indicate your primary and secondary choice of masterclass using the online registration form. At the end of the day, the best e-poster will be awarded with a poster prize.
