

Elisabetta Renzoni biosketch

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Elisabetta Renzoni trained in Respiratory Medicine at the University of Siena, Italy. In 2006, she was appointed Consultant Physician at the Royal Brompton Hospital in the Interstitial Lung Disease Unit. Her specialist areas of clinical expertise include connective tissue disease-associated lung involvement, idiopathic interstitial pneumonias, sarcoidosis and hypersensitivity pneumonitis. Her research is focused on the study of genetic associations with lung fibrosis, fibroblast gene expression of fibroblasts isolated from different patterns of lung fibrosis, vascular and lymphatic remodelling in idiopathic and scleroderma-associated lung fibrosis, and biomarkers predictive of disease progression. She has 53 papers published in PubMed on aspects of respiratory/interstitial lung diseases, and has written several book chapters on ILD and sarcoidosis. She acts as an expert reviewer for a number of international journals.
